Types of Expository Essay

There are six types of expository essays.

- **Definition Essay:** The definition essay defines what the topic is and provides specific information about the topic.
- Classification Essay: In this type of essay, an essay writer divides the topic into categories.
- Process Essay: The process essay explains the method of doing or making something.
- Compare and Contrast Essay: This essay is based on the compare and contrast
 of two things.

- Cause and effect Essay: This essay describes how the cause and effect of something.
- **Problem and Solution Essay:** Describe a particular problem and its solution.

Steps of Writing the Expository Essay

Before you start writing the expository essay, you have enough information to explain your idea. When you know how to write this essay, you do not have to think about how I write my essay.

Below are the steps that you should follow when you start writing the essay.

Choose a Topic

Pick an interesting topic for the essay. Make sure the topic is interesting and engaging. The topic should grab the reader's attention.

Create an Essay Outline

An outline helps and gives you a proper structure of the essay. Through outline, you can easily organize your thoughts and ideas. It works as a road map and provides the right direction for the essay. Some students take a big task of writing the essay outline and consult professional writers. Write the Introduction

When you stop writing the outline, start writing the introduction, and inform the reader about the topic. Give background information to the readers and also state the thesis statement in the introduction.

Write the Conclusion
